
Helping charities and voluntary groups set up, grow and thrive

We supported volunteer groups formed in response to the pandemic

We provided support to groups set up in communities across the District - we stayed in regular contact with them and assisted with finding funding, supplying policies, providing opportunities to network with useful contacts and with other groups, kept all up-to-date with the rapidly changing legislation for volunteers and signposted members of the public to their local support group.

We helped to set up Digital Inclusion and Food Partnership projects.

By co-working with local organisations, we assisted in setting up digital classes and helped to supply IT equipment to local seniors and home-schooling children.

We gave local not-for-profit groups and charities over 200 hours of 1-2-1 support and ran 18 online meetings.
